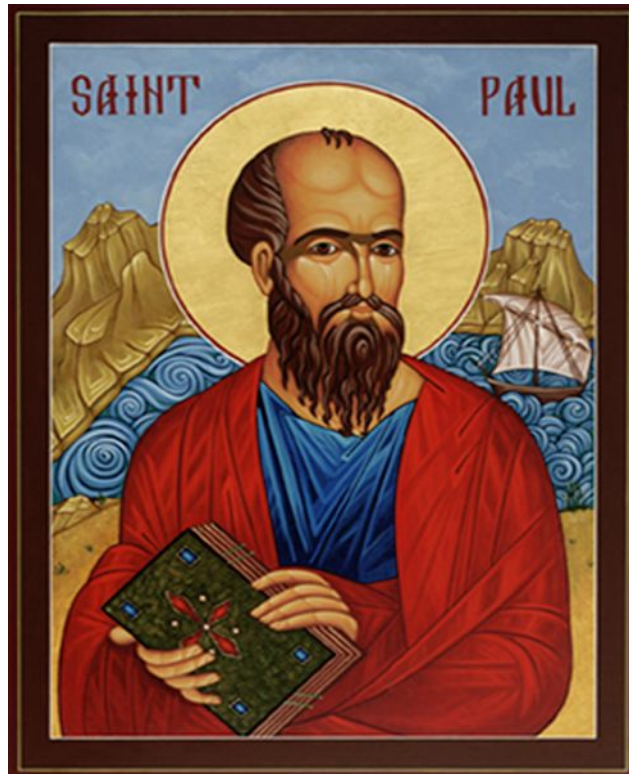

Philippians 2:1-13

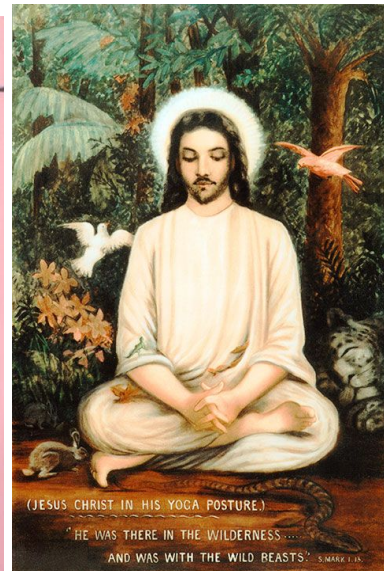
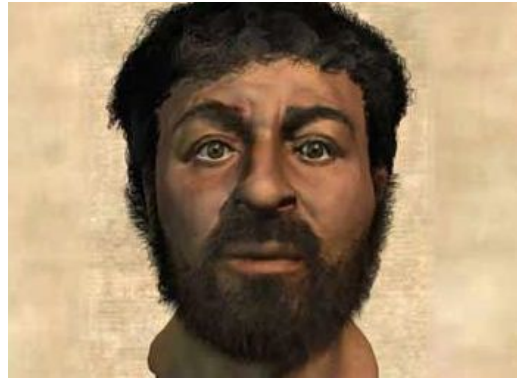
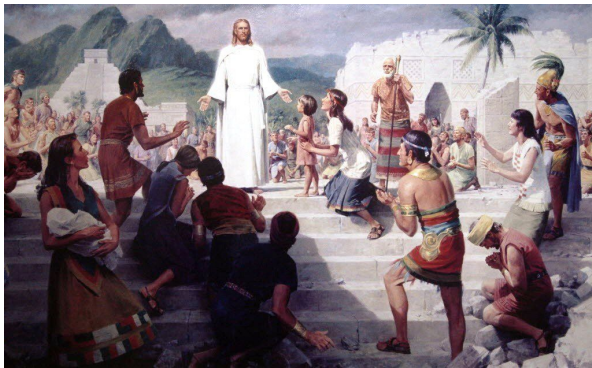
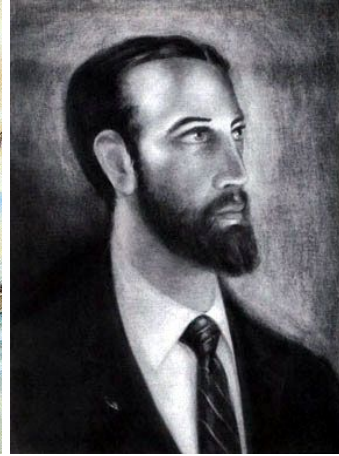
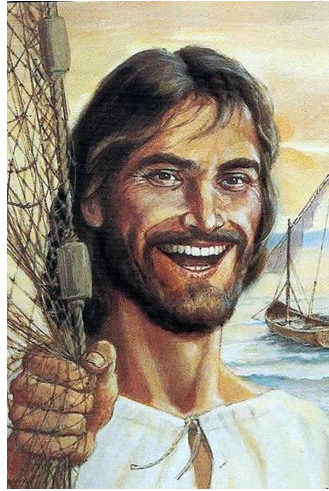
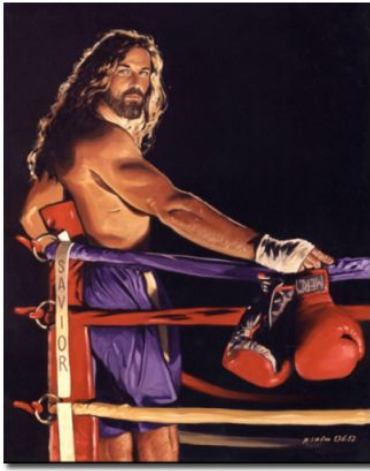
1. Read from more than one translation of the Bible.

1. What is Paul's desire for the church in Philippi?
2. What does it look like to do something out of selfish ambition? Why doesn't Paul want the church to do this?
3. What does Paul say is the alternative to selfish ambition?
4. Paul says we are to have the mind of Christ. What does he mean?
5. Who is Jesus? How does Paul describe who Jesus is?
6. Why didn't Jesus come as an earthly king?
7. Jesus emptied himself. Why? How?
8. Verses 6-11 are considered as part of the "Christ hymn". We don't know if Paul wrote these words himself or if these were part of an early church hymn. Do you have a favorite hymn/song? Which words or phrases resonate the most with you?
9. Paul says in verse 12, "...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling." What do you feel he means by this phrase?
10. "God is at work in you..." How do you feel about God being at work in you? What does Paul mean?
